EXAM CONFIRMATION

DAY OF THE EXAM

- Arrive at the examination venue one hour before the examination start time
- **You must bring the same identification document**, which was used in the application form (Passport/ NRIC/ Student's Pass)

NOTIFICATION OF RESULTS (NO PAPER RESULTS WILL BE ISSUED)

- **BMAT** - A Statement of Results will be issued to each candidate on 26 November 2021. Candidates may access their results using their log-in credentials. The results go to any BMAT institution a candidate has applied to.
 - **BMAT Inquiry on Results deadline** – 03 December 2021.
- **TMUA** - A Statement of Results will be issued to each candidate on 29 November 2021. Candidates may access their results using their log-in credentials. The results go to any TMUA institution a candidate has applied to.
 - **TMUA Inquiry on Results deadline** – 06 December 2021.
- **TSA Oxford and ELAT** - A Statement of Results will be issued to each candidate on 11 January 2022. Candidates may access their results using their log-in credentials. The results will be passed to the Oxford College where the candidate has applied to.
- **CAT/ HAT/ MAT/ MLAT/ OLAT/ PAT/ PHIL** – Test results are not published automatically. Candidates may request their test score from their respective colleges as part of the usual University of Oxford feedback process.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Candidates must register with the British Council (Singapore) by submitting their completed application form and making payment before the registration closing dates. Application forms are available at the Customer Services counters at our Napier Road centre.

TEST RESULTS

ENQUIRY ON RESULTS

Submit a Results Enquiry if you think that there has been an error in the processing or reporting of your BMAT and TMUA results and this does not reflect your performance on the day of the test. Your submission must arrive by **Friday 03 December 2021**. To complete your submission, you must fill out the relevant form - an Application for Results Enquiry. You may send your completed form by fax, post (Special Delivery or equivalent) or as a scanned email attachment to the BMAT and TMUA Support Team, using the address, fax number or email address given on the relevant form. Candidates who took the test at an open centre can submit the Results Enquiry or Appeal form directly to the Admissions Testing Service without an accompanying covering letter.

Please note that the results can go down as well as up as a result of this process, which could affect a candidate's university application.
