## Early Years

They'll learn the reading, writing, grammar, vocabulary, and the social skills needed to be ready for Primary 1.

Each week has a different topic for learners to investigate through our unique British Council materials, designed especially for pre-schoolers. Each day will involve an academic focus, reading reflection and projects for learners to share with classmates and at home. They will learn to work together, communicate confidently, and present in front of the class.

Each day will focus on a different set of tricky words or phonics to teach, test, and use their reading awareness. With crafts and drama games, your child will have the opportunity to share their love of reading with you and their classmates.</p>

<b>Monday 6 to Friday 10 December</b>	<b>K1 to K2</b>	<b>The Write Future: A Writing Skills Course</b>

Designed for those learning to write, this week your child will dive into a story learning all about word classes, exciting vocabulary, and plot. They'll interact with the model text by acting it out, describing characters, and creating story maps to tell them tell the story at home. Then, using the story as a model they'll experiment with adapting the story with new language, and finally getting to express themselves in their own narrative!
