Nursery 1

In today's lesson we will read a story about a young boy and his set of unhappy crayons. The story contains letters written by each of the crayons in his pencil case who are unhappy with him for different reasons. The lesson is ideal for Primary 1 learners as letters are one of the MOE text types for lower primary learners. There will be pre-reading and post-reading exercises and in the final part of the lesson the learners will plan their own letter for a different colour not featured in the book.

Primary 2 and 3

The teacher will work through the answers with the students checking both understanding and also the accuracy of their answers, especially where longer, grammatically correct sentences are required. Finally, the students will also have the opportunity to share their ideas, and - following the message of this story - they will discuss how to overcome obstacles and how to best achieve their future dreams.

Primary 4 and 5

In today's lesson students will identify literary terms, practise prediction skills and listen for specific information, using a poem as the class text. They will practise a PSLE-style open-ended comprehension task that includes both content and inference-based questions, and together with parents, they will have an opportunity to share their personal responses to the poem.

Primary 6

In today's lesson, students will study a nonfiction, historical text on the Space Race. Students will practise skills such as prediction, listening for specific information, close reading and inferring. They will use grammatical and contextual clues to predict missing words in a PSLE-style, open-ended comprehension task and have the opportunity to discuss question types and ways to answer them.

Secondary 1 to 3

Learn English for the Real World

Our Secondary courses place a strong emphasis on helping students build a global mindset by developing their intercultural confidence, critical thinking and analytical reading skills. Stimulating up-to-date topics are linked to current world issues and incentivise students to develop their written and spoken communication skills and achieve academic success.

In today's lesson we will look at part of a listening lesson from a module called Paradise lost. The module theme is tourism. In this module students will:

- discuss the impact of tourism on the environment
- learn and use language for describing environmental problems and their solutions
- · talk about how visitors can give back to local communities
- · practise using negative adverbials to add emphasis.

The final project of the module is to create a travel plan for a sustainable holiday in your country or region.
