Sample course structure from Term 1 (each unit is covered over 5 lessons):

Core text 1: 'Hall of Bulls' (Fiction – Narrative) Core text 2: 'Volcanic eruptions' (Non-fiction – Visual Text) Students will develop these skills to improve their comprehension grades: How to scan for specific information How to make meaning from visual texts Subject knowledge	Text type: Factual recount (news story) Students will develop these skills to improve their composition grades: • How to identify the features of this text type • How to use passive voice • How to structure a report Assessed composition: Complete a factual recount about the eruption of Mount Vesuvius and the destruction of Pompeii.	During this lesson, students will receive individual and group feedback on mistakes made in previous lessons and assignments. They will then be given the opportunity to redo tasks, rewrite parts of their written texts and make corrections based on teacher feedback. They will also carry out supervised peer marking which helps improve their editing skills. With the teacher, they will reflect on their progress and identify areas for improvement.
