**New Directions East Asia 2021** will take place on **December 10 & 11, 2021** with two pre-conference workshops on **December 9**. All events will be held online in the conference platform. ## 1. Pass Types

There are two pass types for the conference: **Standard** and **Complimentary**

**Standard Pass** – the Standard Pass provides access to **ALL sessions** in the main conference (not including the two pre-conference workshops).

**Complimentary Pass** – the Complimentary Pass provides access to all the Breakout Sessions and a selection of Spotlight, Plenary, and Panel Discussion sessions. Please refer to “Session Details” for detailed information.

The pre-conference workshops can be **added on to either pass type** at an additional charge of 5GBP each. If for example, you wanted to attend 1 workshop and purchased the Standard Pass at the regular price it would total £30GBP; if you were adding the workshop on the Complimentary Pass the total would come to £5GBP.
