Lower Primary

Each week on our Primary year-round study camp focusses on a different theme through engaging materials written specifically for international students.

Our aim is to provide a positive and inclusive environment where children are free to express themselves and ask questions. Lessons relate to children's personal experience, with each child being treated as an individual so that language can arise naturally.

Learners will explore age appropriate, relevant topics and tasks that will relate both to their personal and academic lives. They will develop the skills that they need to make them confident speakers and writers through collaborative, creative and contextualised tasks.
